Minor allegedly raped, cops file molestation plaint

Indore: A 11-year-old girl, who was allegedly raped by a 35-year-old man in Alirajpur district, went through the advanced medical examination at MY Hospital in Indore on Friday.

Medical tests of the Class 6 student were conducted, following advice of two woman doctors of Alirajpur district hospital, who after medically examining the girl on Thursday, had failed to arrive at a definite opinion about the girl having been raped or not.

The girl and her family had alleged that that a fa-



ther of two kids had raped her when she was returning to her village in Nanpur area from a marriage ceremony on April 23.

Despite the minor and family sticking to rape claims, Nanpur police had

lodged a case of molestation under Section 354 of IPC against the accused. He was also booked under provisions of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act 2012.

On Thursday, Alirajpur SP Akhilesh Jha called the girl, her family and cops concerned and got the minor's statements recorded before police. Later, the SP sent the girl for the medical examination at Alirajpur district hospital.

"Once the report of advanced medical investigations at MY Hospital is out, future course of action will be decided," Jha said.
